What are CEN & CENELEC? (1)

- The European Standardization Organizations, the members of which are the *National Standards Bodies* of the EU and EFTA
- CEN & CENELEC are private non-profit organisations, incorporated under Belgian law
- 2 Counsellors (European Commission, EFTA)
- CEN-CENELEC Management Centre (CCMC), Brussels
- Recognized by the European Authorities as two of the three competent standardisation bodies for the EU (see Directive 98/34/EC)

What are CEN & CENELEC?

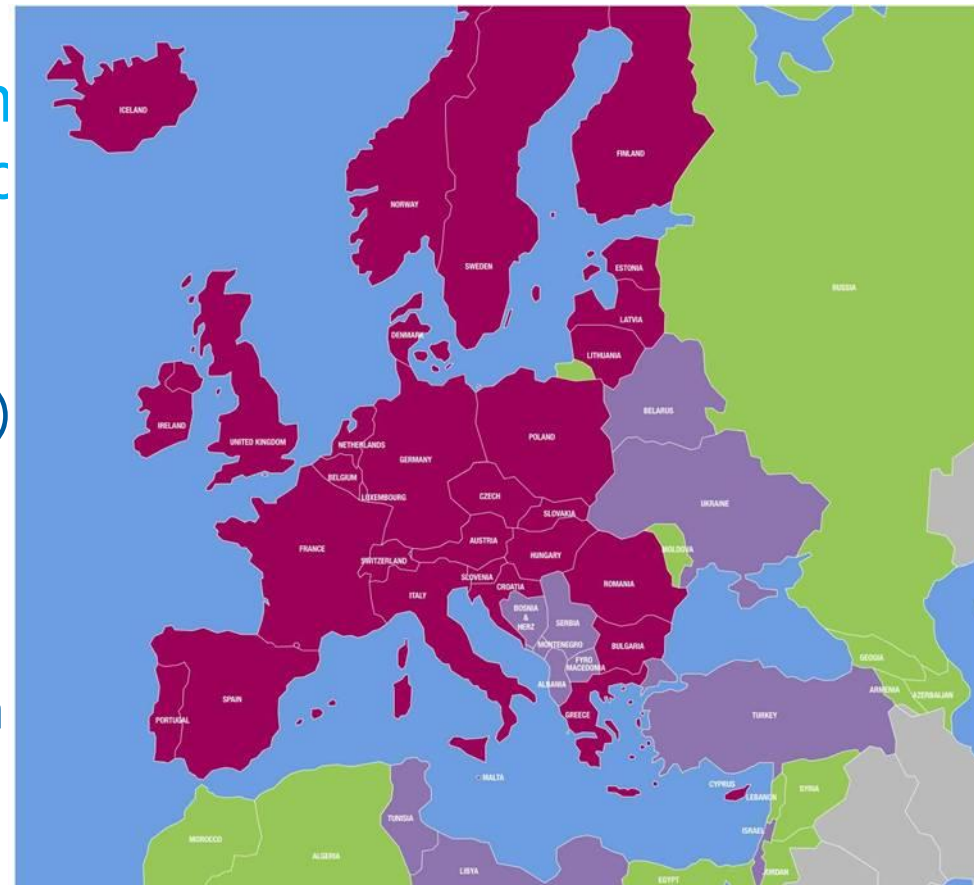
- In CEN, over 60 000 experts of all fields are active in standardisation work
- CENELEC has some 6 500 experts working in 58 Technical Committees and 14 Subcommittees
- Experts from authorities, industry, consumer organisations, etc. (i.e. the stakeholders) participate in the standardisation process, which is open and transparent
